



## Requirements for Retailers and Wholesalers in a Controlled Area Notice (CAN) Situation

2019

This table is intended as a guide to assist markets in managing any movement controls.

Please note you need to follow instructions of the Biosecurity New Zealand officials but this may be of assistance in the meantime .

Good / Service Applying to	Risk / Problem	Requirement	Applies to
<b>Transiting produce</b>	Produce moving into / out of Controlled zone	All produce must originate outside the controlled areas. All produce must be protected from insects. All HOST MATERIAL must be sealed and covered to prevent exposure to insects. Vehicles must not make any stops in controlled areas unless required by law	Wholesalers and retailers
<b>Produce for consumption</b>	Insect HOST MATERIAL	Periodic inspections for infestation shall occur. Can only be sold for consumption in designated control zones unless retailer is approved. Any infestation found on property can cause all HOST MATERIAL to be destroyed.	Wholesalers and retailers
<b>Produce leaving controlled zones</b>	HOST MATERIAL leaving controlled zone	Written authority of regulatory officer required to be allowed to sell produce that will leave control zones. Must be packaged to protect against infestation. Inspections by inspection agents will be allowed. Informative material shall be allowed to be posted in your building.	Wholesalers and retailers
<b>Produce entering controlled zones</b>	HOST MATERIAL entering controlled zones	Once in a zone, produce is not to move to lower risk zones. Once in a controlled zone, produce is to be treated as though it originated in that zone.	Wholesalers and retailers
<b>Produce waste</b>	HOST MATERIAL in large quantities	If the regulatory officer considers an association with fruit fly HOST MATERIAL is possible, the material must be bagged or otherwise contained for destruction as required. Periodic inspections by regulatory officers to verify compliance with these stipulations shall be allowed.	Wholesalers? And retailers

Good / Service Applying to	Risk / Problem	Requirement	Applies to
<b>Vehicles for the transport of produce</b>	HOST MATERIAL debris after loading / unloading	<p>Vehicles transporting fruit and produce must be free of fruit fly HOST MATERIAL; inspection by a regulatory officer may be required.</p> <p>Transported goods must comply with "Fruit for domestic consumption" "Fruit for export", "Imported fruit".</p> <p>Periodic inspections by regulatory officers to verify compliance with these stipulations shall be allowed.</p> <p>Any HOST MATERIAL must be sealed and no HOST MATERIAL exposed.</p> <p>Vehicles exiting controlled zones require a permit.</p>	Wholesalers and retailers
<b>Plant material for disposal</b>	HOST MATERIAL leaving a zone transiting to a disposal facility	<p>A permit is required to remove plant material for disposal.</p> <p>Waste from inner zone to be heat treated prior to disposal at a registered facility, before being deep buried.</p> <p>waste from outer zone ay be heat treated, before deep burial.</p> <p>Collection and transport of plant material shall occur in approved enclosed bins and trucks, and must be sprayed in approved insecticides prior to and post collection and transport.</p>	Wholesalers and retailers

### **Additional requirements for Retailers**

All HOST MATERIAL sold from the premises must be sourced from outside the Controlled Area.

All HOST MATERIAL must be transported directly from your distributor outside the Controlled Area to the premises in an enclosed vehicle.

HOST MATERIAL kept on the premises must be protected from exposure to fruit fly at all times.

HOST MATERIAL must be provided to customers in a sealed plastic bag.

HOST MATERIAL must be accompanied by an itemised receipt as proof of purchase and kept by the customer until they leave the Controlled Area.

All HOST MATERIAL customers must be told that if they intend to transport their HOST MATERIAL outside the Controlled Area, the HOST MATERIAL must remain in the sealed plastic bag until they leave the Controlled Area.

All damaged HOST MATERIAL and packaging associated with HOST MATERIAL must be disposed of in the quarantine bins provided by the MPI.

The “Approved Retailer” signs issued by MPI must be displayed in prominent locations at the premises.

Retailers must ensure employees and distributors are aware of all conditions of the Direction.
